EMDR

EMDR (Eye Movement Desensitisation and Reprocessing) uses bilateral stimulation to reprocess traumatic memories. This then reduces the emotional charge and re-experiencing of these negative memories.

Depending on the complexity of the traumatic memories, various numbers of sessions could be required. This evidence based treatment, for children and adults, is endorsed by the World Health Organisation (WHO) as the leading treatment for Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).
